DUST-MITE-PROOF FABRICS**

Contrary to popular belief, hypoallergenic fabric is not necessarily natural. Both synthetic and natural fabrics are treated with bleaching, antistatic, colouring and cleaning products.

So, you should always check for the correct hypoallergenic product certification that guarantees the absence of dispersed dyes, heavy metal residue and raw materials that come from crops treated with pesticides.

Chateau d'Ax hypoallergenic fabrics are created with non-chemically treated fibres, with a very dense weave to prevent mites from passing through, but wide enough to guarantee perspiration is wicked away for optimal comfort.

STAIN-RESISTANT FABRICS

The perfect combination of pleasant feel and resistance to both oil- and water-based liquids, which do not penetrate the fabric thanks to the special treatment with innovative nanotechnology that acts directly on the yarn making it waterproof.

The result is a water- and oil-repellent, breathable, hypoallergenic and antibacterial fabric that retains its original characteristics even after multiple machine washes.
